All One One All Farm's "Fresh Food for All" Program Combats Local Food Insecurity The Nonprofit Farm and Education Center Plans to Quadruple Its Giving in 2024

June 20, 2024 (Goshen, NY) - Fresh, nutritious, and delicious food remains out of reach for many individuals and families in Orange County. In light of this critical need and aligned with its motto, "All for one and one for all," All One One All Farm (AOOA) proudly introduces its **Fresh Food for All** initiative, specifically designed to address the issue of food insecurity within our community.

The Fresh Food for All program makes wholesome, locally sourced food accessible to all by supplying organic produce and pastured eggs to local food banks. The program began in April 2023 and donated 1300 pounds of produce and more than 250 dozen eggs to food distribution sites in its first twelve months. AOOA aspires to quadruple its giving in 2024 with the long-term goal to contribute 50% of its annual yield to maximize community impact.

"Healthy, nutrient-dense food should be accessible to everyone regardless of economic circumstances," says Alix Daguin, project director at AOOA. "Through Fresh Food for All, we're addressing immediate food needs while also promoting health, sustainability, and community well-being."
